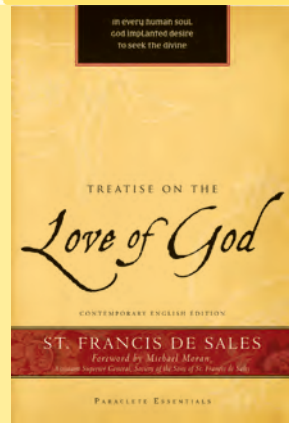

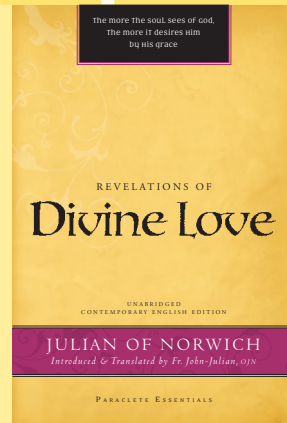

The liturgical season of Ordinary Time runs for roughly twenty-nine weeks, from Pentecost Sunday (June 12, 2011) until the first Sunday of Advent in late fall—an "ordinary" time when we need fresh images for prayer. You will encounter passages from novelists from Dickens and Tolstoy to Dostoevsky and Leif Enger, and poets from George Herbert and St. John of the Cross to Scott Cairns and Kathleen Norris.

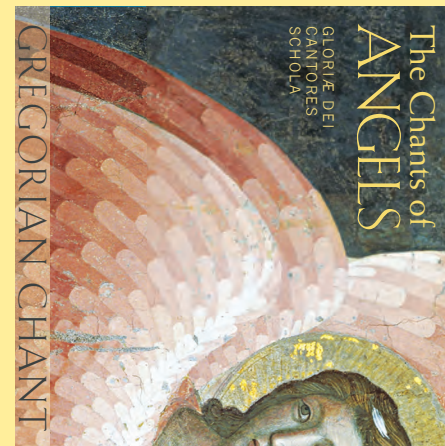

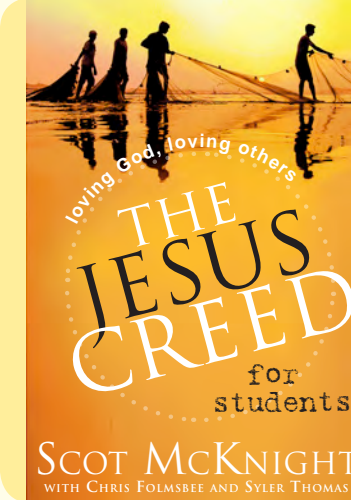

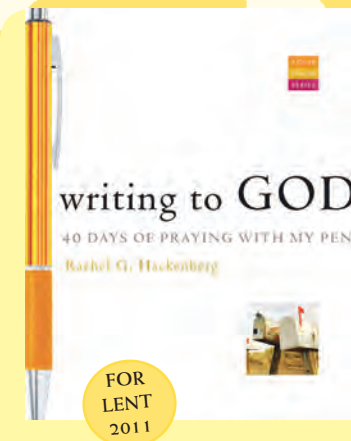


THE JESUS CREED FOR STUDENTS

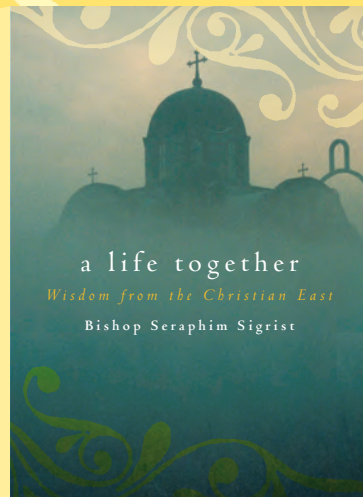


I WILL SEE YOU IN HEAVEN (CAT LOVER'S EDITION)

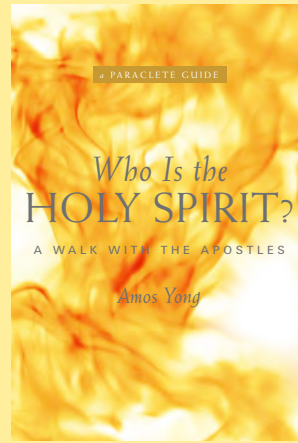
A LIFE TOGETHER WISDOM OF COMMUNITY FROM THE CHRISTIAN EAST

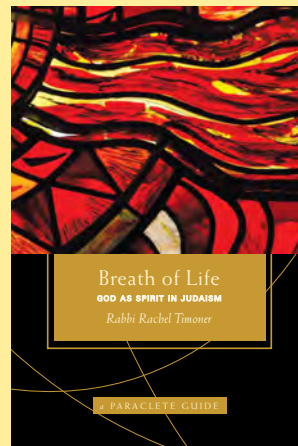


WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT? A WALK WITH THE APOSTLES

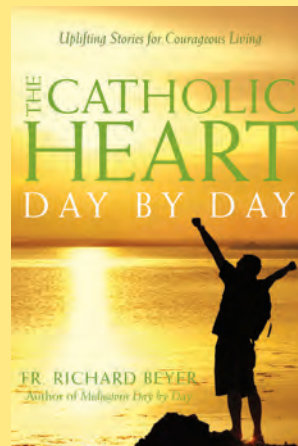
BREATH OF LIFE GOD AS SPIRIT IN JUDAISM
